Welcome Swim Club, Inc. Member Information/ Pool Rules & Regulations

1. Pool Hours

- a. Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 11:00 am to 9:00 pm
- b. Wednesday 11:00 am to 9:00 pm (Semi-private pool party day)
- c. Friday 11:00 am to 9:00 pm (Private pool party day, special event day)
- d. Saturday 11:00 am to 9:00 pm (Private pool party day)
- e. Sunday 1:00 pm -6:00 pm (Private pool party day)

NOTE: Pool hours are subject to change at discretion of Pool Manager/Pool Board (i.e., week(s) before/after schools dismiss or resume school year, attendance, finances, weather, maintenance issues, etc.)

2. <u>Pool Manager/Lifeguard</u>

- a. It is the Pool Manager's responsibility, at its sole discretion, to enforce supervision of Pool Rules & Regulations.
- b. Only <u>Board Members</u>, <u>Pool Manager</u>, and <u>Lifeguards</u> are allowed in the area behind the concession stand. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>.
- c. Lifeguards on duty during opening hours are to be at their stations on time.
- d. Lifeguards are not considered babysitters and do not cover the Kiddie/Wading Pool area.
- e. Lifeguards are not permitted to give private swimming lessons while on duty.

3. Members

- a. Dues must be paid before using the pool facilities each season. Members must sign in at the window and identify themselves and guests prior to entering the pool area.
- b. Dues must be paid by the assigned due date. Dues paid after the assigned due date must be paid online (no checks). A late fee of \$25.00 will be accessed. Due date will be communicated via the Welcome Swim Club Facebook page, as well as a newsletter sent to the Member email address on file.

- c. All swimmers are required to shower prior to entering the pool. Persons with cuts, blisters, open wounds, boils, or plaster casts should refrain from using the pool until healed.
- d. No running in the enclosed area of the pool. Absolutely NO boisterous or rough play at any time. Spitting, spouting water, blowing nose, etc. in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- e. Pool approved rafts/floats are allowed in the shallow end of the pool, if not crowded with swimmers (Lifeguard & Pool Manager's sole discretion).
- f. Only "pool approved" toys will be allowed inside the fence and/or the pool. No real sports balls are allowed in or around the pool.
- g. Parents are **<u>FULLY RESPONSIBLE</u>** for their children at all times, and should supervise the use of the pool by their children and enforce Pool Rules & Regulations.
- h. Parents are not permitted to leave children under thirteen (13) years of age at the pool without a responsible adult pool Member's supervision, or babysitter who is at least sixteen (16) years of age or older.
- Babysitters that are caring for pool Member's children are allowed to use the pool facilities without the use of Member's guest pass, <u>following Pool Manager's approval</u>. However, if a Member is present along with the babysitter, the Member will be required to use a guest pass. Babysitters are not allowed to use Member's guest passes to bring other guests.
- j. Children five (5) years of age and under will not be admitted to the pool unless with a

responsible adult pool Member.

- k. Parents are not permitted to leave child(ren) unsupervised at the pool unless they are thirteen (13) years of age or older and child(ren) have scheduled and passed a swimming test which, consists of swimming the length of the pool (without touching bottom) and supervised and approved by a Lifeguard on duty or Pool Manager. Parents must sign their child(ren) in and also leave an emergency contact name and number with the Pool Manager and/or Lifeguards on duty.
- I. All children under thirteen (13) years of age must be properly supervised by an adult at all times.
- m. The Kiddie/Wading pool is limited to children under five (5) years of age and must be supervised by an adult at all times. Lifeguards do not supervise the Kiddie/Wading pool.
- n. Children five (5) years of age and older are <u>NOT</u> allowed in the Kiddie/Wading pool.
- Drinking/eating will be allowed in designated areas only. <u>No drinking/eating allowed in the</u> pool. <u>Alcoholic beverages are NOT PERMITTED.</u> Users are responsible for clean-up.
- p. Members are responsible for leaving their seating and/or eating area clean and neat. ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS BOTTLES OR CONTAINERS ARE ALLOWED.
- q. All persons are prohibited from using alcoholic beverages, including pool parties, on pool premises. Violators will be asked to leave.

- r. No tobacco products, including e-cigarettes, vaping, etc. are permitted on the pool property.
- s. No public display of affection.
- t. No profanity.
- u. No pets allowed on pool property.
- v. Swimmers must wear pool appropriate, non-revealing swimwear. No thongs, cheeky bottoms, beach attire or cutoff shorts are allowed in the pool. Rash guards are allowed.
- w. No goggles or floatation devices are allowed while using the diving board. This is a safety guideline from the American Red Cross.
- x. All injuries should be reported to the Pool Manager immediately.
- y. All complaints should be reported to the Pool Manager/Pool Board, in writing.
- z. Telephone use is limited to two (2) minutes and may be used for LOCAL calls only.
- aa. ALL Members must refrain from distracting Lifeguards and follow their instructions at all times.
- bb. Pool Board will establish opening and closing dates.
- cc. Guest(s)
 - i ALL Members are required to sign in, including any guests, before entering the pool area. The adult Member holding the membership must be present to sign the guest in.
 - ii Members will receive eight (8) guest passes for the season.
 - iii If a Member wishes to use their guest pass, they must notify Pool Manager or Lifeguard on duty, at the time of entry into pool area, to sign-in guest(s). All children five (5) years of age and older will be considered a guest and must use a guest pass.
 - iv After using your initial eight (8) guest passes, Members have the option to purchase a Guest Pass Punch Card containing ten (10) guest passes. The cost of a Guest Pass Punch Card is \$50.00. <u>Members are limited to ONE Guest Pass Punch Card PER</u> <u>FAMILY, which expires at the end of the pool season.</u>
 - v <u>Members must be present with their guest(s) at all times</u>, and guest(s) must depart when the Member leaves the pool.
 - vi If a Member is under 18 and wishes to bring guest(s) to the pool, an **ADULT** member holding the membership will be required to complete the Minor Liability Waiver form available at the guard room. **The Minor Liability Waiver form must be completed in person at the guard room by the adult member. The form CANNOT be completed and sent in with the minor.** A Minor Liability Waiver must be completed each pool season in order for Minor members to bring guest(s) to the pool. Parents are not permitted to leave child(ren) unsupervised at the pool unless they are (thirteen) 13 years of age or older.

- vii Any guest exhibiting disruptive behavior or violating **Pool Rules & Regulations** will be asked to leave the premises and <u>will not be allowed to return at any time during the pool season.</u>
- viii Non-members who arrive at the pool attempting to solicit a member to sign them in as a guest will not be tolerated or allowed.
- dd. Pool closing due to weather or maintenance issues will be at the discretion of the Pool Manager/Pool Board.
- ee. It is the Pool Manager's responsibility, at its sole discretion, to enforce supervision rules.

Infractions for violation of Pool Rules & Regulations:

First Offense: Warning Second Offense: 15 Minutes Time Out Third Offense: Sent home for the day

4. Pool Parties

- Pool Members who have paid their dues in full may rent the pool for private parties on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays from 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM and semi-private parties on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM. For the semi-private parties, the pool <u>will not</u> be closed but you will have private use of the covered area.
- b. To schedule a party, complete the pool party request form found here: <u>https://www.welcomeswimclub.com/poolparties.html</u> and email to infowscnc@gmail.com. Please provide a return phone number, date requesting party and number of guests. Members also have the option of sending a private message through the Welcome Swim Club Facebook page.
- c. The fee for a private party is \$200.00 for Friday and Saturday, \$150.00 for Sunday, and a semiprivate party is \$100.00.
- d. Pool Manager must know the exact number of guests attending the party before the scheduled party date in order for Pool Manager to schedule sufficient Lifeguard coverage. If there will be more than fifty (50) guests swimming, you will be charged an additional \$25.00 for a 3rd Lifeguard.
- e. All parties must be paid in full when booked via the online payment link or through the Pool Manager. Once payment has been received, your pool party date will be reserved. We <u>do not</u> accept checks at the pool.
- f. Party hosts are required to clean up all areas of the pool after the party. If excessive trash and/or the pool areas are left in an unclean manner, a clean-up fee of \$50.00 will be charged at the Pool Manager/Pool Board's sole discretion)
- g. Member's may not use (or combine with any other Member) guest passes to be used in lieu of scheduling a private or semi-private pool party.

h. If any Member has more than eight (8) guests present at any time, it will be considered a "semi-private" party and the Member will be billed for a "semi-private" party.

***The Board of Directors reserves the rights to amend the above Pool

Rules & Regulations at any time during the pool season***
